<b>ABSTRACT/CV</b>	Dr. Robert Steiger is Associate Professor at the Department of Public Finance at the University of Innsbruck, Austria. Steiger has worked on climate change and tourism for over 10 years and has contributed to the national Climate Change Assessments of Austria (APCC) and Switzerland (CH2014), the Special Report on Climate Change and Tourism (SR19) in Austria, and the Second Climate Change Assessments of Austria (AAR2). He is Co-Chair of the Climate, Tourism and Recreation Commission of the International Society of Biometeorology. He is also lead expert of the international Tourism Panel on Climate Change (TPCC). Since 2023 he is Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Outdoor Recreation and Tourism. Furthermore, he is responsible for the Tourism Bachelor and Master Programs at the University of Innsbruck.
